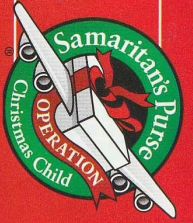

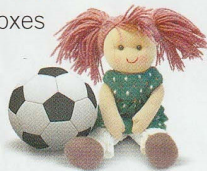
PERSONALISE & PRAY:

In many parts of Togo to be born blind is to be born cursed. Children are often rejected by their families and scorned by teachers and classmates. Blind and visually impaired students at Village of Light School were recently blessed with shoebox gifts. Operation Christmas Child volunteer Cynthia recalls the students were ecstatic to open their gift boxes.

"The children were so happy despite the fact that they couldn't see the things," she said. "They touched the gifts and said 'What is this?' and 'What is that?' They jumped for joy. They felt loved."



Josephine (pictured left) said her favourite gifts were a doll, a cup, and a bag of plastic building toys. "When I found the doll in the box, it gave me a lot of joy," smiled Josephine.

The school's Principal Raoul said, "Operation Christmas Child is so powerful for these students because it reminds them that people around the world care for them and that God does too."

After receiving shoebox gifts, many children are invited by local churches to participate in *The Greatest Journey*, a 12-lesson Bible discovery course, where they discover more about the Nativity and how much Jesus loves them through Bible stories.
